- 2. To buy, sell, assemble, distribute, and otherwise acquire, or to own, hold, use, sell, assign, transfer, exchange, lease, license or otherwise dispose of goods, wares, merchandise and all other personal property of every class and description.
- 3. To purchase, acquire, own, hold, use, lease, rent, sublet, sell, exchange, sub-divide, maintain, construct, operate, a
 deal in real estate, improved or unimproved, and buildings of an
 kind or description, and any and all other property of every kind or
 description, real, personal or mixed, and any interest or right
 therein wheresoever situated either in California or other states of
 the United States, the District of Columbia, territories and possessions of the United States, and foreign countries.
- 4. To enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limitation as to amount with any person, firm, association, or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government, foreign or domestic, or other municipal or government subdivisions.

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- 5. To conduct and carry on, directly or indirectly, unvelopment and promotional activities.
- 6. To carry on any activity whatsoner, either as principal agent or partner, which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of this corporation, and to conduct its activities in this State, in other states, the district of Columbia, the territories and possessions of theUnited States, and any foreign countries.
- 7. To have and to exercise all powers conferred by the General Non-profit Corporation Law of California upon non-profit corporations as such law is now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

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The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall except where otherwise expressed by in no wise limited or restricted by any reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers. Notwithstanding anyof the above statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not engage in activities which in themselves are not in furtherence of the purpose set forth in Paragraph a of this Article one, and nothing contained in the foregoing at tement of purposes shall be construed to authorize this corporation to carry on any activity for the profit of its members or distribute any gains, profits or dividence to any of its members as such except upon dissolution or winding up.

THREE: This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Mon-profit Corporation Law of the State of California.
